The bell from the U.S.S. Hannibal, which is now in Kiwanis Park, will be displayed at the top of the memorial. The U.S.S. Hannibal ship was built in 1898 and used in Spanish-American War, World Wars I and II. The ship



was decommissioned in 1944 and the U.S. Navy sent the bell to the city of Hannibal.
