Pumpkins in the Park rules

- 1. The main part of each entry must be a pumpkin or a member of the pumpkin family.
- 2. Pumpkins may not be completely carved or hollowed out.
- 3. One pumpkin per person.
- 4. Pumpkins entered will be displayed in City Hall until Nov. 3 and can be reclaimed then or will be disposed of.
- 5. Objects and materials used to decorate pumpkins may not be reclaimed until after the contest, under any circumstances.
- 6. Objects, paper and materials of any kind may be pinned or glued to pumpkins. Participants may also draw or paint on their entries, cut designs into their surfaces or dress them up. Again, do not carve or hollow out your pumpkin.
- 7. No electrical device may be used as part of any entry.
- 8. Entries must be brought to Central Park from 9 to 10 a.m. Oct. 30. Judging will be 10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., winners will be announced at 12 noon.
- 9. Age groups are children 12 and under and adult 13 and over. Awards will be given to first place in each category.
- 10. Categories for awards: Scary, Creative, Mayor's Choice, Facebook Favorite.
