FISH MAY BE TAKEN ONLY WITH POLE AND LINE WITH LURE OR BAIT

(No trot lines, bank poles, limb lines, jug lines, etc.) No more than three (3) poles may be used by one person.

A TROUT PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL ANGLERS REGARDLESS OF AGE IN ADDITION TO THE PRESCRIBED FISHING PERMIT TO POSSESS AND TRANSPORT TROUT.

ONLY ARTIFICAIL LURES AND UNSENTED SOFT PLASTICS MAY BE USED FROM NOVEMBER 1ST THROUGH JANUARY 31ST.

DIP NET, THROW NET, SEINING OR TRAPPING LIVE BAIT IS PROHIBITED.

HUNTING IS PROHIBITED
